We are seeking mission-driven, creative, and energetic individuals to join our team and serve as a Youth Program Leader within our High School Scholars Program.

The ideal candidate is committed to our mission and has experience and passion for working with youth. The role will co-manage the After School Tutoring Program with the Program Coordinator.

Key Responsibilities:

- Maintain a supportive and productive environment on a daily basis that ensures students are getting adequate academic support each day
- Provide supervision and support to a team of 6-8 Tutor/Mentors and facilitate daily workflow, including tracking attendance, assigning tutor/student pairs and groups, and managing the classroom spaces and student behavior
- Work with the Program Coordinator to plan and deliver daily academic enrichment activities
- Function as a tutor (when needed) by providing students with homework help, checking work, subject tutoring, and assisting with test preparation
- Function as a positive role model and provide mentorship to youth
- Support the Program Coordinator with Tutor/Mentor training, supervision, and evaluation
- Support program data collection, maintaining student progress reports, and other program administrative needs

Qualifications:

- Must have college sophomore standing or higher
- Must have experience working with youth in the 14-18+ age groups
- Professional, organized, reliable, punctual, self motivated and team player
- Excellent communication skills
- Experience with supervising others and/or leadership position(s) preferred
